

#### 2.2.5. Encouraging self-regulatory initiatives and exploring EU certification schemes

The Commission continues to consider that **self-regulatory initiatives** by data controllers can **contribute to a better enforcement of data protection rules**. The current provisions on self-regulation in the Data Protection Directive, namely the scope for drawing up Codes of Conduct<sup>32</sup>, have rarely been used so far and are not considered satisfactory by private stakeholders.


