# U.S. Artificial Intelligence Legislative Efforts in the 118th Congress Impacting Digital Infrastructure

- Implementing the NIST AI Risk Framework - \$10 million proposed by several Senators January 5, 2023 for funding NIST's AI Safety Institute (USAISI)
- ARIA Act - introduced in the Senate November 15, 2023 - AI Research, Innovation and Accountability Act of 2023 would require developers to conduct risk mitigation assessments, notify users of GenAI content, and direct NIST's standards relative to critical infrastructure
- AI Labeling Act - introduced in the Senate October 24, 2023 - requiring AI generated content to be labeled
- Senate forum on the Future of AI, Chaired by Senate Commerce Chair - August 23, 2023
- House Commerce C&T Subcommittee Hearing November 14, 2023 on uses of AI in communications networks
- House Full E&C Committee Hearing December 13, 2023 on AI, innovation and data privacy including with respect to digital infrastructure

# Broader U.S. AI Legislative Efforts in the 118th Congress

- REAL Political Ads Act – introduced in the Senate May 15, 2023 – requiring disclaimer on AI-generated political ads
- No AI FRAUD Act – introduced in the House January 10, 2024 – attempting a federal framework to protect Americans from “Fake Replicas And Unauthorized Duplications” (aka “FRAUD”) of voice and likenesses
- PREVAIL Act – introduced in the Senate July 10, 2023 – to reform patent law and strengthen patents in light of increased use of GenAI
- U.S. State efforts – e.g. Wisconsin Governor’s Task Force on Workforce and AI, focusing on workforce training and development – December 2023 and ongoing
