
1. プロダクトビジョンの設定：
  - a. プロジェクトの目標や目指す成果を明確にします。
  - b. ステークホルダー（利害関係者）との協議を通じて、アプリの大まかな方向性を決定します。
2. ユーザーストーリーの作成：
  - a. ターゲットユーザーを特定し、彼らのニーズや要望を「ユーザーストーリー」として記述します。
  - b. これらのストーリーは、機能の優先順位付けやスプリント計画の基礎となります。
3. ロードマップの作成：
  - a. プロジェクトの大まかなタイムラインを設定します。
  - b. 主要なマイルストーンやリリースの目標を定義します。
4. 優先順位付けとバックログの作成：
  - a. ユーザーストーリーを基に、プロダクトバックログを作成し、優先順位を決定します。
  - b. バックログはプロジェクト全体を通じて更新され続けます。

In Agile development, the process of requirement definition and planning is flexible and iterative. It includes the following steps:

- 1. Setting the Product Vision:**
  - a. Clarify the goals and desired outcomes of the project.**
  - b. Determine the general direction of the app through consultations with stakeholders.**
- 2. Creating User Stories:**
  - a. Identify the target users and document their needs and demands as "user stories".**
  - b. These stories serve as the basis for prioritizing features and planning sprints.**
- 3. Creating a Roadmap:**
  - a. Establish a rough timeline for the project.**
  - b. Define key milestones and goals for releases.**
- 4. Prioritization and Backlog Creation:**
  - a. Create a product backlog based on the user stories and decide on their priority.**
  - b. The backlog is continuously updated throughout the project.**




An initial version of a product having basic functionality that can be produced quickly and well enough to be tested by users




